

DIPLOMA SUPPLEMENT LABEL

What is that.

The Diploma Supplement (DS) is a document established by the European Commission, the Council of Europe and Unesco within the work of the Bologna Process, to facilitate the dissemination of qualifications in Europe and internationally, both for the purposes of continuation of studies in academic institutions, both for the purpose of entering the world of work. The DS is a qualification recognized and usable in Europe, both for study purposes and for employment purposes, it is compiled in English and Italian, and contains a description of the knowledge and skills obtained by the student at the end of his or her studies. which complement and complete the official title.

The DS is summarized in 8 sections: *personal data, educational qualification, qualification level, curriculum and grades, functions of the qualification, additional information, certification, description of the national higher education system*, which contain information on the nature, context the content and status of the studies carried out and completed by the student, inserting the reference qualification within the **Framework of Italian Qualifications (QTI)** in comparison with the **European Qualification Framework (EQF)**

The Academy of Fine Arts of Foggia issues to all students who achieve the 1st and / or 2nd level Diploma, automatically (and free of charge) also the Diploma Supplement, written in English.

Release

The DS is issued to all the graduates of the New Order courses activated on the basis of the Law of 21 December 1999, n. 508

The DS is issued at the end of each cycle of studies (I Level Three-year - II Level Two-year - III Level Post Diploma Courses) together with the original qualification at the request of the interested parties.

The issue of the DS is not foreseen for the Graduates of the Old System (Regulations prior to the D.M. 508/99).
